APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The Summer Institute is a full-time, immersive professional development programme that requires Fellows to be engaged and committed even before the start date of the programme with preparatory work.

The curricula is designed to develop key leadership and communications capabilities, further holistic industry knowledge, and develop innovative and systemic thinking. Growth in these areas is assessed throughout the programme in several ways. To be awarded an official certificate of successful completion of the programme, the Fellows are required:

- **Minimum of 95% attendance throughout the core programme hours:** Attendance, punctuality and engagement will be tracked.
- **Ongoing self-review:** Fellows will be asked to undergo several self-review and reflection processes to assess their own development journey.
- **Ongoing peer review:** Fellows will be asked to provide constructive feedback to their peers to support their development.
- **Mentor assessment:** Mentors will be asked to provide feedback, guidance, and reflection spaces to support the Fellows' development. Mentors will also be ensuring engagement and understanding of the subject matter.
- **Third-party assessment:** The WNU Team and speakers can provide feedback, guidance, and reflection spaces to support the Fellows development.

The official language for all programme elements is English; even for networking and social aspects. Oral, written and spoken proficiency is required. We encourage non-native English speakers to trust their capabilities and start practicing their language skills once accepted.

This programme will test your limits and push you out of your comfort zone in many different ways. Those who get most out of the experience come with an open mind and an understanding that this is a chance to practice adaptation and resilience in a safe environment.
