### 34<sup>th</sup> KINAC/INSA International Training Course

- Theme: Introduction to Strategic Trade Controls

#### ■ Overview

• Date	May 27 – 31, 2024
• Organizers	Korea Institute of Nuclear Nonproliferation and Control (KINAC) in cooperation with the Nuclear Safety and Security Commission (NSSC) of the Republic of Korea (ROK)
• Venue	International Nuclear Nonproliferation and Security Academy (INSA), 1418 Yuseong-daero, Yuseong-gu, Daejeon, Republic of Korea
• Language	The course is conducted in English.

#### ■ Participation

• Number of Participants	The course is open to 2 people from each country with a maximum of 36 participants. The number of participants may be subject to the prevailing condition of the organizing institution.
• Participant's Qualification	The course is designed mainly for individuals from government and organizations involving in strategic trade control. Please make sure that applications are not the participants of the 3rd, 9th, 13th, 18th and 24th KINAC/INSA international training courses held on November 10-14, 2014, November 14-18, 2016, November 6-10, 2017, July 2-6, 2018 and June 17-21, 2019 respectively since a notable portion of the contents from the previous ones recurs in this course.
• Application Procedure	Applicants should submit the attached nomination form to the established official channel (competent authority such as the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the national atomic energy related authority) by <b>April 19, 2024</b> . The official channel should endorse the form and send it to the Embassy of the ROK. Applicants will be notified their selection results through email by KINAC no later than <b>April 26, 2024</b> .
• Financial Arrangements	Participants are eligible to apply for financial assistance funded by the KINAC. Applicants should indicate their request for financial assistance in the nomination form. However, the request for financial assistance may not be accepted for all applicants, depending on the budget. Travel grants include the round-trip flight (economy class e-tickets provided by the KINAC) between the participant's nearest international airport and the international airport in the ROK, accommodations around the venue (the hotel booked by the KINAC), and/or daily allowances (per diem, covering meals and transportation expenses) between 26 May and 1 June.
• ROK visa information	An invitation letter from the KINAC will be sent to those participants in need of a visa.

• Purpose of the course	The course aims to give awareness to participants at the beginner level about strategic trade controls to satisfy and implement international norms(NSG, MTCR, WA, AG).
