Subject: Regional Workshop on Nuclear Law in Russian Language, Dushanbe, Tajikistan, from 28 to 31 March 2023

Dear National Liaison Officer / National Coordinator,

I am pleased to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing the above event under the IAEA technical cooperation project RER0048, “Enhancing National Legal Frameworks”.

The purpose of the event is to provide the participants with a broad understanding of all aspects of nuclear law and render a comprehensive overview of the relevant international legal instruments in this field, including recent developments; an opportunity to discuss and exchange views on nuclear law; and assess or update the assessment of the existing legal framework in each of the participating Member States and develop or update work plans for strengthening or enhancing the national nuclear legal framework.

The attached Information Sheet provides further details, including technical and administrative aspects of the event. Selection of participants will be in accordance with IAEA procedures. Member States are strongly encouraged to identify female participants.


The IAEA will provide non-local participants with a round-trip air ticket based on the most direct and economical route between the airport nearest the participant’s residence and Dushanbe or a travel allowance to purchase an air ticket. Travel details will be agreed with the participants upon receipt of their official nomination. Participants will also receive an allowance from the IAEA sufficient to cover their costs of lodging, daily subsistence and miscellaneous expenses for the duration of the event in line with IAEA rules and procedures.
