The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) presents its compliments to the IAEA's Member States and has the honour to draw their attention to the IAEA Marie Skłodowska-Curie Fellowship Programme (MSCFP).

As Member States are aware, the IAEA MSCFP helps to encourage young women to pursue careers in the nuclear related field. Over the five years since its launch in 2020, the IAEA MSCFP has already supported 760 female students representing 129 Member States studying in 76 countries around the globe. As of August 2025, 413 fellows have completed their master's programme with support from the IAEA MSCFP. Most fellows have subsequently either pursued an internship facilitated by the IAEA or employment or PhD studies in their field.

The IAEA MSCFP is an ongoing initiative with the aim of ensuring that more women have an opportunity to pursue advanced education in the nuclear related field. Accordingly, the Secretariat has the honour to inform Member States that the application period for the IAEA MSCFP 2025 cycle opened on 1 September 2025 and will close on 31 October 2025. Female students in the nuclear related field may apply for scholarships for the academic years 2025/2026 and 2026/2027.

Selected applicants will receive a scholarship for master's programmes in nuclear related studies from accredited universities as well as internship opportunities facilitated by the IAEA. Consideration is given to geographic distribution, the field of study distribution, linguistic diversity and whether the applicant has received previous support from the IAEA.

Member States are invited to facilitate the dissemination of this information by transmitting it to the relevant national authorities for further circulation among potential donors, partners, universities and students.
